- Conduct regular inspections and maintenance of machinery and equipment to ensure conformance with operational standards.
- Perform routine preventative maintenance work on machinery.
- Maintain records of all service, maintenance and refurbishing work carried out on machines and equipment.
- Operate machine tools to fabricate parts required.
- Read blueprints and schematic drawings to determine work procedures.
- Maintain inventory equipment, supplies and materials.
- Perform other related duties incidental to the work described.

**Requirements:**

- Red Seal Millwright ticket required.
- Minimum 3 years' experience as a millwright
- Previous experience with electrical, hydraulic, mechanical systems, electronics, welding, and machining is required.
- Ability to work safely and efficiently, knowledge of safety regulations and practices are required.
- Ability to anticipate, troubleshoot and solve problems.
- Strength and agility are necessary for lifting and climbing.
- Ability to follow instructions and read blueprints.
- Ability to develop and sustain cooperative working relationships with co-workers, contractors, and company management.
- Strong communications skills and fluency in English
- Experience in maintenance in a manufacturing/ food production plant is an asset, but not a requirement.
- Must be available for all hours of operation including overtime and weekend work as required.
- Must have access to a vehicle.
